WELCOME TO THE PRE-CONSTRUCTION OPEN HOUSE!

Representatives from the City of Lincoln, engineering consultant JEO, and construction contractor MTZ are available to discuss the project and answer your questions. No formal presentations are planned tonight.

PROJECT DETAILS

This street rehabilitation project will:

- Repair pothole-causing cracks
- Resurface and smooth the street
- Upgrade sidewalk ramps for wheelchair accessibility

SCHEDULE

Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin mid-May, weather permitting, and be completed by September 21.

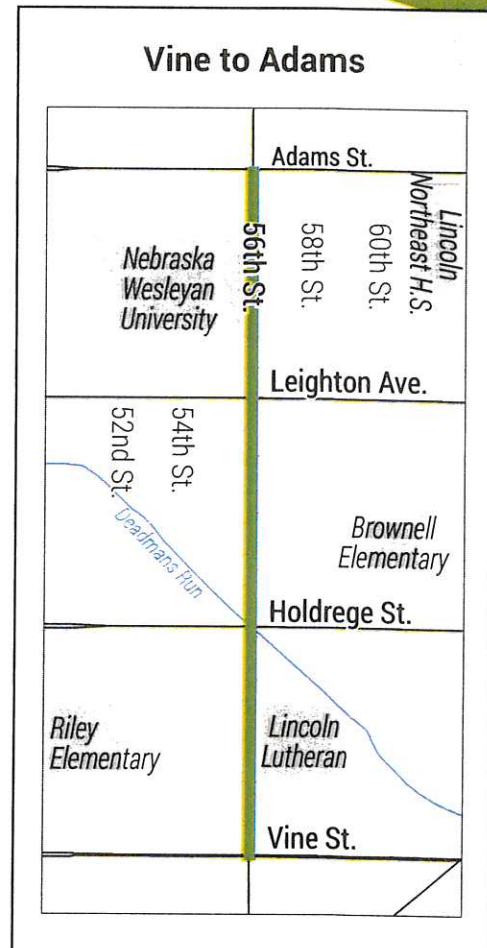
EXPECTED TRAFFIC IMPACT

- The traffic management plan was developed in consultation with schools and local businesses.
- 56th Street will be open in both directions during sidewalk ramp reconstruction.
- 56th Street will be open in one direction at a time while it is being resurfaced.
- 56th and Holdrege Streets will be closed on a Monday during off-peak hours to complete resurfacing.
- 56th and Leighton Streets will be closed for two days during off-peak hours to weatherproof the joints between asphalt sections.

! Notifications to traffic changes will be communicated via message boards in advance.

ACCESS DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Access to local residences that front the project will be maintained except when concrete repairs are needed in front of driveways and during asphalt placement. Closure of driveways will not exceed seven (7) days.
- Access to businesses that front the project will be maintained except for brief periods during asphalt placement.
- The Contractor will notify all businesses and property owners at least seven (7) days in advance of any changes in access.
